Dear Parents/ Guardians,

RE: ROLL-OFF SESSIONS FOR COMPETITIONS, CHANGE OF JUNE TRAINING SCHEDULE & ORDER OF JERSEYS

We will be having 2 roll-off sessions on 1st February and 5th February for selecting boys to represent the school in the **National Age Group Championships (NAG)** which will take place **during the March holidays**.

In addition, we will be having 2 roll-off sessions on 5th April and 16th April for selecting boys to represent the school in the **National School Games Tenpin Bowling Championships 2018** which will take place in **Term 3**.

Please take note that no make-up sessions will be arranged if your son is absent on any of the roll-off sessions regardless of the reason for absence.

The selection criteria for both competitions is primarily based on the 3 Cs as follow

- Competence - aggregate score of the 2 roll-off sessions for each competition, taking into consideration the annual ranking results
- Character - good sportsmanship and discipline
- Commitment - minimum 80% attendance

The school will be paying for all the registration fees for the team(s) selected to represent the school in the NAG and no fees are required for the National School Games Tenpin Bowling Championships.

As mentioned in ClassDojo, there has been a change in the schedule for the training during June holidays. The training on **18 June** has been **cancelled**. There will be **training on 20 June and 22 June** instead. The training will be conducted at Orchid Country Club from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

If your child would not like to represent the school in the NAG as you have made your own arrangement to register your child as a **private participant** or your child has other commitments or will be travelling during the March holidays, kindly indicate in the attached reply slip so as to facilitate the selection process.

We are ordering new bowling jerseys this year as we have recruited some new Team A members since end of last year and we also noticed that some boys have outgrown the jerseys which they have ordered last year.

If your child is selected to participate in the NAG and/or National School Games Tenpin Bowling Championships 2018 which will be held over a period of three to four consecutive days, he has to wear his jersey during the competition. Therefore, we would like to encourage every Team A player to own two jerseys. After subsidy from the school, every pupil only needs to pay **\$21 (cash)** for two jerseys.
