**DESIGNER** A **Designer** creates designs that creatively showcase unique memories and objects to honour our heritage. (Recommended for P5 NEAMs)

**HISTORIAN** A **Historian** has keen interest in past events. He studies and conducts research on historic events. Historians play a key role in helping us learn and understand our shared past. (Recommended for P5 NEAMs)

**AMBASSADOR** A **Heritage Ambassador** is passionate about heritage and constantly reaches out to others to learn and participate actively in heritage-related programmes. (Recommended for P6 NEAMs)
