Choosing a Secondary School

- Based on PSLE aggregate score
- Express, Normal (Acad) and (Tech)
- Selection to be made after release of results
- All eligible affiliate students posted first
- Affiliate Schools are SJI and St Patrick's
- S1 Information Booklet
- Internet System



Changes to Affiliation (for 2019 P6)

- MOE will reserve 20% of places in each course Express, Normal (Academic) and Normal (Technical) at every affiliated secondary school for application from students who do not benefit from affiliation priority.
- This is to also address concerns that affiliates may receive an excessive advantage in school admissions.



Changes to Affiliation

- MOE will implement this change starting from the 2019 PSLE cohort for admission into Secondary 1 in 2020 (For P5 2018 boys). The 2-year advanced notice is MOE's usual requirement for affiliation changes. Schools that have adjusted their affiliate minimum requirement in the past have given their affiliates a similar runway.



Affiliation to St Joseph's Institution (SJI)

- Based on the demand and academic performance of previous cohorts of affiliates in our school, we do not expect to be affected by the change in affiliation priority for boys qualifying for SJI.
- All of our affiliate applicants are likely to gain admission to SJI. Regardless, we still encourage all our students to continue to work hard and do their best, as always.



Affiliation St Patrick's School (SPS)

- Based on the demand and academic performance of previous cohorts of affiliates in our school, we anticipate that a small number of our affiliates applying to the Express and Normal course may potentially not gain admission on the basis of affiliation priority.
- If so, these students will be considered together with non-affiliated students for posting into the school based on their PSLE scores. Any affiliates who are eventually not posted to their first choice will be considered for their next choice school.



Direct School Admission

- Application around May/June of P6 year
- Need to be alert and check school's website
- Selection Phase : June to August
- Once accepted, posting is final
- P5 Results Critical if applying for DSA under academic areas
- Testimonials and Letters of Recommendation



Admission to SJI

- 'O' level Track (4 years)
- Cut-Off 238 pts (7 classes of 30)
- 2017 Non-affiliate Cut-Off 244 pts
- International Baccalaureate IP Track (6 years)
- IB IP Track 253 pts (4 classes of 30) or DSA
- No Affiliation for IP Track



DSA to SJI 'O' Level Track (2019)

- Aptitude in one of the following areas of sport: Athletics, Badminton, Football, Gymnastics, Hockey, Rugby, Sailing, Squash, Table Tennis.
- Applicants who meet any one of the following will be at an advantage:
 - Member of Top 4 Team in National Inter-school Championship.
 - Member of Top 2 Team in Zone Inter-school Championship.
 - Quarter-Finalist in National Age-Group Individual Championship or a major Championship organized by the Singapore Primary Schools.



DSA to SJI (IB)

- Outstanding engagement and achievement in one or more areas of talent: academics (e.g. Math Olympiad), sports, arts, leadership and service;
- General Ability Test (Principal's Academy Inc)
- Quality of mind
- Personal and relational characteristics



Admission to St Patrick's School

- DSA – Military band
- Scholarship for those above 234



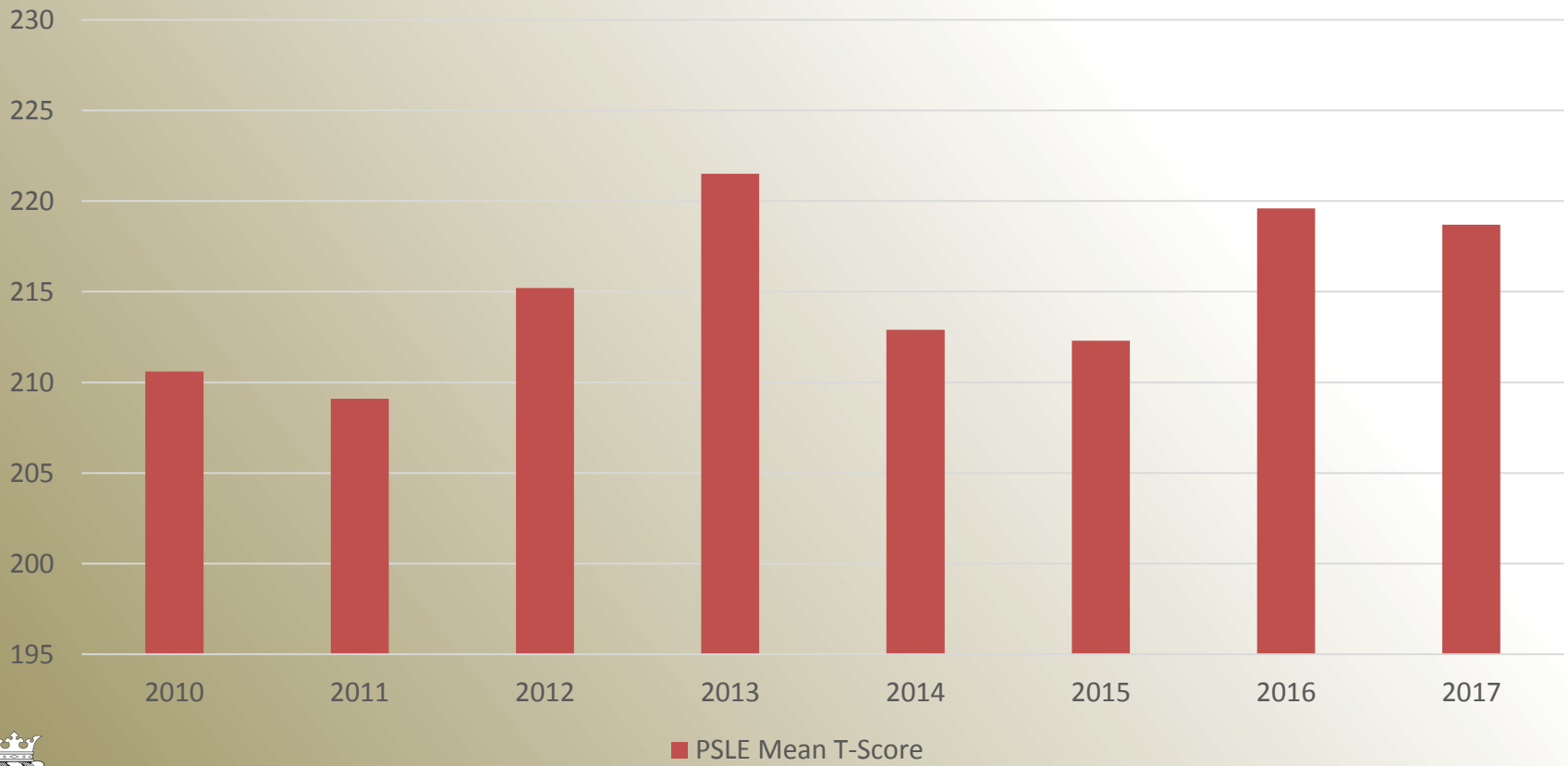
External CCA Recognition

PSLE Aggregate Calculation

- Not the marks of the examination.
- Rank or position of a pupil's performance compared to all other pupils in that subject.
- All 4 / 3 subjects that the pupil offers carry **equal** weighting.

PSLE Aggregate Calculation

- $T = 50 + 10 (X - Y) / Z$
- X is the pupil's mark for the subject
- Y is the average mark (mean) scored by all the pupils
- Z is the spread of the marks around the average mark (standard deviation)
- We have no way of ascertaining what the Y and Z is for any particular exam

- Beware of Over-Reliance on Tutors
