






START-RIGHT PROGRAMME

In the first 3 days, a P4 buddy will be assigned to help your son during recess:


- a) Looking for a seat in the canteen
- **b)** Getting ready to order (choose food item)
- c) Handling money
- d) Queuing up for food
- e) Washing of hands
- f) Wiping-down after eating
- g) Refilling water bottle and visiting the toilet
- h) Visiting common areas (e.g. library, field, etc)







LEADER IN ME: 7 HABITS OF HIGHLY EFFECTIVE KIDS



Leader in Me and 7 Habits for Happy Kids teach children essential life skills- like responsibility, collaboration, and selfconfidence- empowering them to become proactive, goal-oriented individuals who can lead themselves and positively influence others.



CAUGHT DOING GOOD

A school initiative to **encourage positive behaviours** by recognising and rewarding pupils when they are observed doing something beneficial, helpful, or kind.







ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL ARRANGEMENTS

Note:

- 1) Please **refrain from using different modes** of transport for arrival and dismissal, and/or on different days of the week to avoid confusing your child.
- 2) Pupils who are taking **school bus** will be gathered and meet their respective bus drivers/assistants.
 - Appropriate behaviours on the bus are to be observed and seat belts must be worn.
- 3) Pupils who attend **student care** (in school) will be sent to their assembly area.







DROP-OFF IN THE MORNING

- Parents/Guardians who drive your son/ward to school are to follow the security personnels' directions, move to the designated drop-off points and drive carefully within the school zone
- Pupils who come to school by **school bus** or **own transport** should alight at the **bus bay** and proceed straight to their respective classrooms or hall.

DROP-OFF (MORNING)

- Pupils who are being sent by parents/care-givers and enter via gates
 1, 2 or 3 will also be directed to their respective classrooms/hall.
- Parents **are not allowed to enter** the school from Day 2.
- All visitors are to report to the **General Office**.





Gate 2- Derbyshire Road








- Pupils who will be picked up via **own transport** will assemble with their form teachers before proceeding to the bus bay.
- **Priority will be given to school buses** at the bus bay.
- Parents/Guardians can only drive in after
 1.45pm after all the school buses have driven off.

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Bus Bay



• Parents/Guardians/Care-givers who are picking up their sons/wards are to enter school via Gate 1 (Essex Road) and wait at the foyer.

- Pupils who are **waiting for their** siblings will be taken to the concourse.
- They are **to be seated** and **wait**.



Concourse (Siblings' waiting area)








Pick-up by **parents/guardians/care-givers at the following gates**:

- Gate 2: Derbyshire Road
- Gate 3: Moulmein Road
- This group of pupils will be **taken to the respective gates.**













ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

□ Thermometer

- To be put in school bag daily in case of need
- Do check that it is functional periodically
- □ Face mask (x3) + sanitiser + pocket tissue
 - In case of need

Student Handbook

- Will be distributed by form teacher in the first week
- □ Lanyard with details on dismissal arrangement
 - Will be given by form teacher on Day 1

- allow teachers time to resolve any conflicts between/ • amongst students and finally seek reconciliation


