In the first week, a P4 buddy will be assigned to help your son during recess:

- a) Looking for a seat in the canteen

- f) Wiping-down after eating
- g) Refilling water bottle and visiting the toilet

- Teachers and prefects will be there to guide them to their classrooms.





- Parents can only drive in after 1.45pm after all the school buses have left.




Bus Bay




- Pickup by caregivers who enter via Gate 1 – Essex Road or
