## THE GROWING YEARS (SEXUALITY EDUCATION) PROGRAMME 2023

The Growing Years programme (GY) in schools is about enabling students to understand the physiological, social and emotional changes they experience as they mature, develop healthy and rewarding relationships including those with members of the opposite sex, and make wise, informed and responsible decisions on sexuality matters. Growing Years is premised on the importance of the family as the basic unit of society. This means encouraging healthy, heterosexual marriages and stable nuclear family units with extended family support. The teaching and learning of Growing Years is based on respect for the values and beliefs of the different ethnic and religious communities in Singapore on sexuality issues. Please note that this programme DOES NOT cover the topic of safe sex or use of contraception.

- 2. The goals of Growing Years programme are:
  - (i) To help students **make wise**, **responsible and informed decisions** through the provision of accurate, current and age-appropriate knowledge on human sexuality and the consequences of sexual activity;
  - (ii) To help students know themselves and build healthy and rewarding relationships through the acquisition of social and emotional skills of self-awareness, management of their thoughts, feelings and behaviours, development of empathy for others, possession of effective communication, problem-solving and decision-making skills; and
  - (iii) To help students **develop a moral compass, respect for themselves** and for others as fellow human beings, premised on the family as the basic unit of society, through the inculcation of positive mainstream values and attitudes about sexuality.
