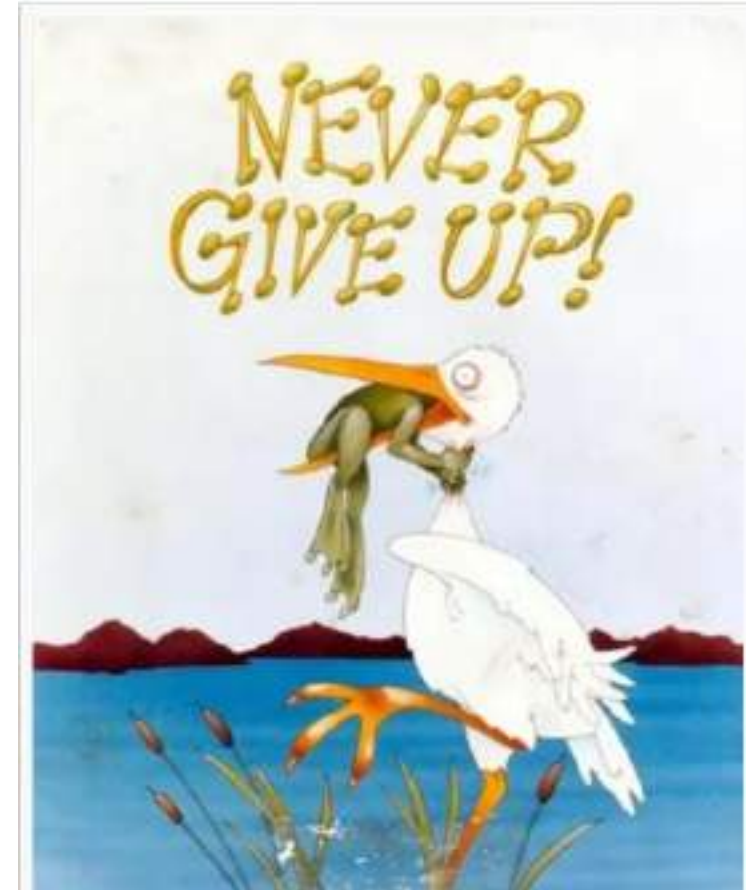

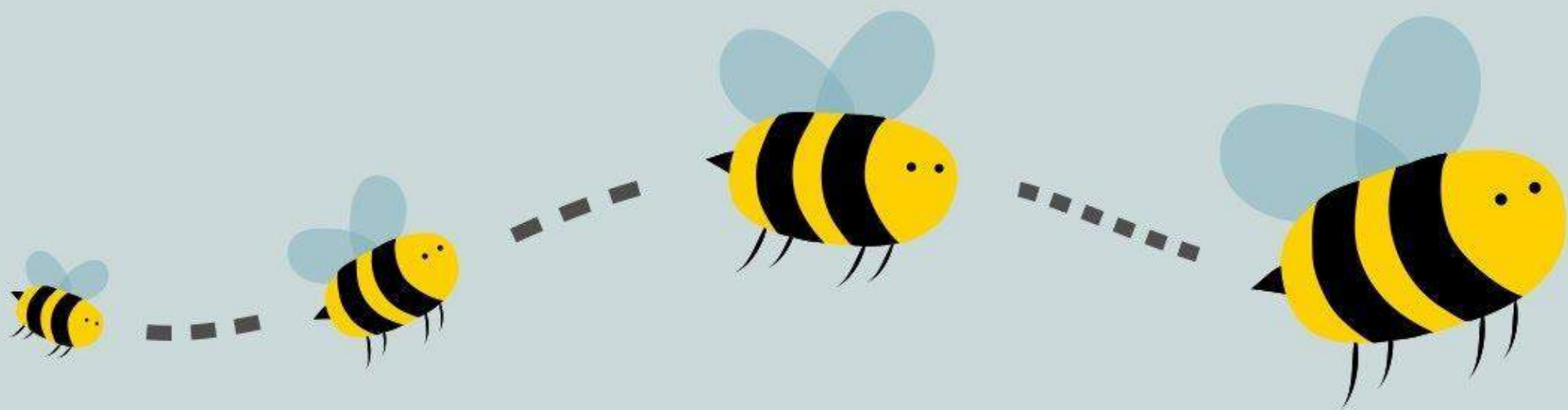

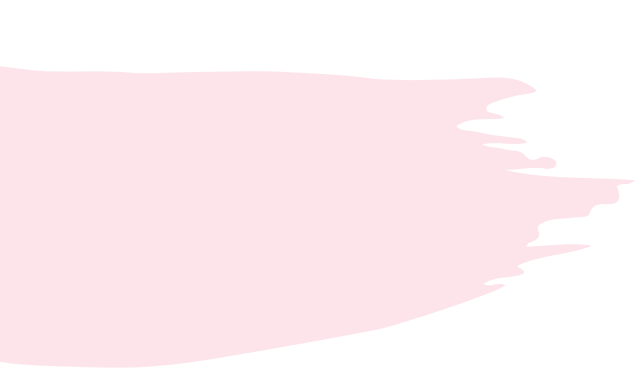

Assaulting or Fighting



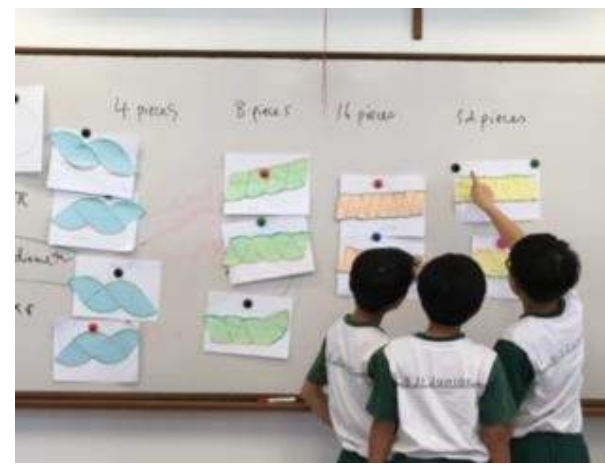
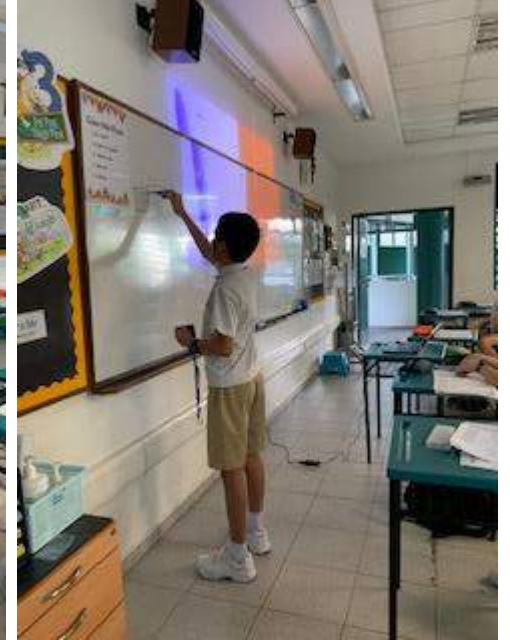

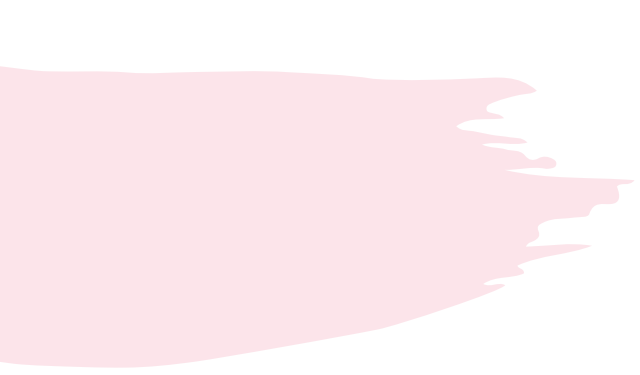

Assessment Policy & Guidelines

- Any student who is **absent** for ALL **examination** papers will need to produce a **medical certificate** from a doctor in order for the teacher to key in '**VR**' (Valid Reason) in the report book.
