

# WHAT are we Expecting for P6 SYLLABUS?


- Time span for each unit

# Paper 1- Composition Writing

#### Requirement

- Min 100 words (CL/TL), 150 words (ML), 200 words (HMT) in 50 min
- MOE approved dictionary is allowed.

#### **Reality**

 The ideal length of a composition should be around 250 words. It is difficult to have substantial content when a composition is too short.

# Common Problems with Composition:

#### **Contents:**

- Story was incomplete or out of point
- Pictures were left out
- Content is not develop
- Grammar structure were wrong or consistent use of simple sentence structure.
- Vocabulary either inappropriate or too "bland"



## ADVICE on COMPOSITION Writing...

- Analyse the given Topic/Picture
- Plan the Story sequence and idea arrangement
- Ensuring not to write out of point
- Use the guiding vocabulary/questions/content given properly
- Develope the story
- Making full use of the dictionary



## ADVICE on COMPOSITION Writing...

#### **Rich Vocabulary**

Memorise to Learn, Learn to Apply

#### **Good Grammar**

Revise on grammar structure (P2 to P4 TB)and composition segments (P3 to P5 TB)

#### **Story Content**

**Achieved a Balance between Memorised Content vs Story Content**

# ADVICE on Comprehension...

#### **Build Up Reading Skills**

Consistent Reading. Learning how to pick out information from different paragraphs to form an answer for comprehension questions.

Be familiar with vocabulary in the textbook (glossary of key words can be found at the back of the book) >> know how to use it in the correct context



## Oral

- READING (20M)
- VIDEO STIMULUS/CONVERSATION (30m)
  - Students will be prompted by tester.
  - Topic will be closely tagged to the video viewed

## Oral- video stimulus conversation

- Usually 3 or more questions.
- Pupils are required to speak in-depth of the topic with regards to the video

Example of a Conversation topic:

Can you tell me one good deed you have seen in the video?



# Sample – 1 min video with a short narratives



\* Format is the same for CL, ML, TL except that the narrations are in the respective language



## Advice on oral conversation...

- Be engaged in conversation using MT actively
- Engaged in conversation on topic that happens in a pupils daily life and how can the pupils can make proposal/change to family, school and society
- Build up vocabulary. Main issue does not usually stems from content but the lack of vocabulary to express themselves e.g. e-scooter in MT.
